It has been almost three months since Russia invaded Ukraine. Ukrainians are being forced to defend their right to exist and live within their own homeland, with Putin and the Russian Federation seeking to erase Ukraine from the map of Europe.

As part of a global initiative, the Ukrainian Government is asking people around the world to keep Ukraine on the map by renaming streets which house Russian embassies and consulates to “Ukraine Streets”.

Ten countries have already done so, including Canada, Poland and Norway, while others have started the process.

We know it won't stop the war. But this symbolic act will lift the spirits of Ukrainians, remind Russia that Ukraine will always exist, and demonstrate **Australia's support for freedom and democracy.**

SINCE THE FULLSCALE INVASION OF UKRAINE ON 24 FEBRUARY 2022
THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION HAS:

 killed 226 Ukrainian children and wounded 417	 destroyed more than 250 cultural institutions and at least 116 buildings of spiritual significance
 fired more than 2,000 missiles on Ukraine	 deported about 1.2 million people to detention centres in Russia, including around 200,000 Ukrainian children
 destroyed 6,800+ civilian buildings	 committed 10,800+ war crimes (registered)
 damaged more than 500 hospitals, 100+ of which were demolished completely destroyed more than 500 hospitals	 caused the loss of nearly 5,000,000 jobs in Ukraine
 forced more than 6 million Ukrainians to leave their country (according to UNHCR), & displaced around 11 million people within the country	 killed 3,496 civilians, including more than 1,000 who were found in or around Bucha, a town northwest of Kyiv, with many showing signs of torture after Russian troops withdrew in April 2022

Natalia with her 11 year old twins. The family survived a Russian cluster bomb attack on Kramatorsk train station. But mother and daughter have lost their leg/s.



Nadiia Trubchaninova lives in the Kyiv region. Her village was destroyed by Russian forces. Every day she searched in ruined Bucha for her son. May he rest in peace.




97 year old WWII veteran Ivan Lysun and his house which was destroyed by the Russian military in Zolochiv, Kharkiv region.



Journalist Valeria Glodan and her three month old baby daughter died after Russian forces bombed Odesa in late April.
